Note from Ms. Allen

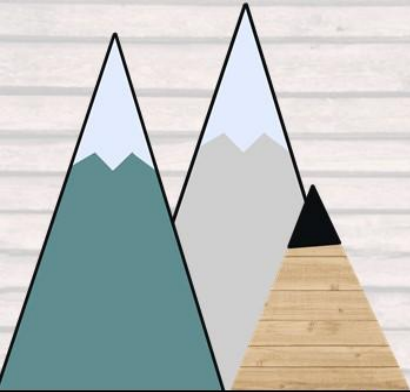
It's hard to believe we are already approaching one month back to school!! We have been busy learning, growing, and working hard in the classroom. I am so proud of the progress we have made in such a short time.
