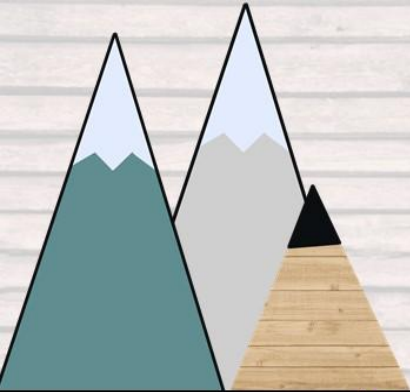
Math Moment
