- For graduation, students should wear "Sunday best." This means no jeans or shorts. Hair should be fixed for a graduation cap to be easily placed on their head. Girls who wear a dress should wear shorts underneath. Sleeveless dresses should be worn with a sweater or jacket.
- Graduation RSVPs should be returned by May 8th. This helps me plan for seating and refreshments.
- Some of our countdown events will allow students to bring things from home or dress out of uniform for the day. Please see the info below:

May 3rd Show-and-Tell: Students should bring in one item that is special to them to share with the class.

May 6th Beach Day: Students can wear beach attire to school. This includes shorts, beach hats, sun dresses, sunglasses, leis, etc. They may also bring a beach towel and a floaty to sit on for the day!
