Billing Invoices

Cafeteria and Extended Care balances are communicated at the start of each week electronically or in Monday folders.

Extended Care balances are available in PowerSchool. Hard copy statements are provided at the start of each month.

Monday balances reflect activity from the prior week's services in addition to any outstanding balance.

****Please note that Extended Care services may not be used when the account balance is over \$50.****

Afternoon Dismissal

- Vehicles enter from "I" Street and form six single file lanes starting along the retaining wall in the main parking area (Lane 1).
- The first vehicle in each lane should pull all the way up to the orange safety cones.
- Once all students are in vehicles, the supervisor releases each lane one at a time. All vehicles must exit via the lane in front of the Shamrock Center and turn right onto 17th Street.
- Students who walk after school are supervised in a designated area until all vehicles have been dismissed.
- Parents who walk up to get a student after vehicles begin moving must remain with the walkers until the first two lanes have been dismissed.
- Parents waiting on students late to the parking lot must pull up and park in the upper lot and wait to exit until all other vehicles have exited.
- At no time is a vehicle to back out of the parking lot or from the dismissal pattern. Once cars begin to exit the parking lot there is no foot traffic until the walker group is dismissed.
- Parents who walk up to get a child may not exit, once the dismissal of cars is initiated, until all rolling traffic stops.



Choice School Voucher Scholarship K-8

All voucher applications have been submitted for students in grades K-8. There is paperwork in today's Monday folder to be signed and returned to school no later than this Friday, Sept. 4th.

Tuition invoices have been prepared by the parish bookkeeper. The tuition balance for registered members of the parish is: \$59.84/student The tuition balance for non-Catholic families is: \$259.84/student.

The yearly balance changes based on updated tuition scales and the voucher award amount by county.

Morning Arrival

Please review and remind your people. Thank you!

- Cars must pull all the way up to the next available spot closest to Entry 1.
- **Children should exit only on the passenger side as soon as the vehicle stops.**
- **Parents do not exit the vehicle.** If your child isn't able to exit the car independently, park in the angled spots next to the parish office and walk the student to Entry 2.
- The safety lane is used for students to walk to either Entry 1 or 2.
- **At no time may a vehicle exit the car line and move around another vehicle. Please follow the traffic pattern until exiting the SVS parking lot.**
