Consideration	Protocol
School Program	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School resumes on August 11th, 2021 • Students in grades PK-8 attend in traditional in-person learning.
Ingress/Egress	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrival pattern follows white arrows. Vehicles must pull all the way up to next available position and students must exit from the passenger side only. There is a safety lane in place to walk to Entries 1 and 2. • PK-5 students enter/exit using Entries 1 or 2. 6-8 students enter/exit using Entry 3. • Students arriving after 8 am are admitted at Entry 9. (office) • School visitors are admitted at Entry 9 and sign-in at the office.
Health Survey	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Faculty members monitor daily health. • Parents agree to monitor their children's health using the daily self-screening checklist. • Parents are required to sign school Health and Safety Document. • In the event of student absence, the school office must be notified by 8:30am. If absence is related to illness, parents must state symptoms and onset. • After consultation with a medical provider, the office must be notified if a student or staff member is experiencing symptoms related to COVID-19 and should not report to school or work. • School administration provides guidelines for quarantine, isolation, and/or return to school. • School administration notifies any individual or group in the event that quarantine is necessary or recommended.
Illness during School day	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • School nurse monitors student illness and evaluates symptoms to determine appropriate protocol. • Prescribed medication, inhalers, etc. will be administered by the school nurse. • Authorization form must be completed and on file in the office in order for medication to be dispensed. • Nurse's station is available for students who become ill during the school day. • Students leaving school due to illness will be picked up at Entry 2 between the hours of 8am and 1:30pm. • After 1:30pm students leaving school will be picked up at Entry 9.
Social Distancing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Direct instruction about the necessity and importance of physical distancing, hand-washing, and all safety protocol is provided to students. • Classroom set-up and seating eliminate close contact to the extent possible.
Food Services	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Handwashing is required before and after meal service. • All food service personnel are required to wear face masks and gloves. • Students sit in grade level clusters. • All tables/seating are sanitized between each lunch period.
Common Areas	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Masks or face shields are worn in common areas and when in transition. • Drinking fountains are disabled. Water bottle filling stations remain in place. • Students have individual water bottle from home.
Disinfection and Sanitation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Custodial staff maintains regular cleaning during the day. • Desks and hard surfaces are disinfected regularly. • Good hygiene is encouraged before and after sharing items. • Students have hand washing breaks throughout the day. • Supplies are available such hand sanitizer, wipes with bleach, sanitizing stations, and classroom dispensers.
Emergency Contact	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All contact information and emergency contact for each student is current and accurate. • A parent, guardian, or alternate contact must be available for each student during the school day. • Jupiter settings for each student must allow for parents to receive text messaging and emergency notifications.
Masks/Face Coverings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Face masks are required when social distancing is not optimal and close contact cannot be avoided. • Any appropriate face mask is permitted. • Alternative PPE is permitted for students with special needs as outlined in and ISP or personal health plan. • Visitors to the building must have face mask to enter the building.
Exposure	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Guidelines and recommendations for isolation and quarantine will be followed. • A virtual learning plan will be provided for any student in isolation or quarantine.
